Re: Invitation to the 4th ATU Preparatory Meeting for WTSA-20, hosted (online) by Ghana from 27 September to 1st October, 2021 (12H00- 15HOO EAT)

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite you to participate in the 4th ATU Preparatory Meeting for World Telecommunications Standardization Assembly (WTSA-20) organized in collaboration with International Telecommunications Union (ITU) and kindly hosted by the National Communication Authority (NCA) of Ghana from – 27 September to 1st October, 2021 back to back with 2 validation workshops of e-skilling model framework for Africa and IPv6 migration strategy for Africa.

As you are aware, the next WTSA-20 is due to take place in Hyderabad, India from 1st to 9th March 2022 preceded by the Global Standards Symposium on 28th February 2022 and as such, Africa needs to intensify its efforts to finalize the preparations on issues of concern to the continent with regard to the WTSA-20 agenda so as to submit to the Assembly for consideration in due time.

As you may recall, the 3rd preparatory meeting for WTSA-20 that took place in Accra Ghana in July 2020 was not able to finalize the formulation of all the proposals to the Assembly in view of the new contributions that were received and therefore the need for the final meeting to prepare adequately and ensure that the proposals to the Assembly are concluded. It is therefore important that these issues and many others are followed through in order for the region to come up with strong African Common Proposals and positions to the Assembly.

The third meeting held in July 2020 also deliberated on the candidatures to various ITU-T Study Groups and the TSAG and Member States were encouraged to send their proposals in accordance with the circular letter of the ITU-T which was sent to all the Member States on 3rd September 2020. Countries wishing to nominate candidate(s) were requested to send the names of their nominees with their respective CVs to ITU with a copy to the General Secretariat for compilation and harmonization. As we are preparing to attend the Assembly, we also seek Members who are willing to appoint their representatives for the various WTSA-20 committees, to submit the candidatures to the ATU Secretariat for coordination purposes.
