ADMISSION TO SOUTH AFRICA: DELEGATES TO ATTEND THE 3RD AND FINAL AFRICAN TELECOMMUNICATION UNION (ATU) PREPARATORY MEETING FOR WORLD TELECOMMUNICATION STANDARD ASSEMBLY (WTS-24): HOSTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATION & DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES: FROM 12 – 16 AUGUST 2024: JOHANNESBURG

Visas may be issued to bona fide delegates attending the above mentioned event, provided a letter of invitation is submitted / name list of persons appointed by Government / organisations (copies also accepted), if nothing detrimental is known and they are not prohibited or undesirable in terms of the Immigration Act 2002 (Act 13 of 2002), as amended.

Visas may not be issued to delegates whose journey starts or entails passing through the yellow fever belt of Africa or South America if they are not in possession of yellow fever certificates. The Yellow Fever Certificate is not required if a person remains in transit for less than 12 hours.

PLEASE BE INFORMED THAT FOR AN EVENT HOSTED BY ANY GOVERNMENT ENTITY THE ORGANISERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION.

Kindly note where applicants originate from countries where South Africa has no Mission, the applications should be couriered or posted by registered mail to the country's accredited Mission.
