Please accept the compliments of the ATU General Secretariat.

I am happy to inform you that the arrangements for the 7th Ordinary Session of the Conference of Plenipotentiaries (CPL), planned for 23-24 July 2026 in Abuja, Nigeria are proceeding well.

In compliance with Article 2.2 of the ATU Convention, Cape Town, December 1999, Rev. Harare 2014, I have the honour to invite you to officially submit to the General Secretariat your country's interest, if any, to be elected as a member of the ATU Administrative Council for the period 2027-2030 in elections to be held during the CPL in July 2026 in Abuja, Nigeria. The official letter of your country's candidature should reach the General Secretariat not later than 23th June 2026.

I also wish to draw your attention to Article 9 of the Constitution which stipulates that in electing Member States to the Administrative Council, the CPL should have due regard to the equitable distribution of seats among the sub-regions of Africa as defined by African Union (AU) and should be in order with their contributions to the Union.
