It is my pleasure to inform you that the 7th Ordinary Session of the Conference of Plenipotentiaries of the African Telecommunications Union (ATU) will be held in Abuja, Nigeria from 23 – 24 July 2026 at the kind invitation of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

The Conference of Plenipotentiaries is the supreme organ of the Union which meets every four years in an ordinary session. It consists of duly accredited delegations of Member States headed by Ministers in charge of telecommunications or their representatives. It convenes to, among others things, determine the general policy which the Union must follow to achieve its objectives, examines and approves the strategic plan, the programme of activities and the four-year budget of the Union, elects the Members of the Administrative Council and the Secretary General.

The CPL-26 will be preceded by three (03) other related meetings, namely:

- Special Session of the Administrative Council from 16 – 17 July, 2026 (Members only);
- 3rd Regional Preparatory Meeting for ITU Plenipotentiary Conference (ITU PP-26) on 18 July, 2026; and,
- Conference Preparatory Committee (CPC) from 20 – 21 July, 2026.
